


What is LIBER?

✓ Project to create a Virtual Central of Excelence in Digital preservation

✓ Digital preservation roadmap for libraries based on a survey of experts from national and research libraries





Europena Libraries

- ✓ The Europeana Libraries project is working to make **5 million** digital objects from **19 leading European research libraries** freely accessible on <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/jhear.2007/jhear
- ✓ Opening of the aggregation service of TEL to research libraries
- ✓ New European Library Portal





Europeana Newspapers

- ✓ Provide more than 18 million newspaper pages to the EUROPEANA service
- ✓ Digitization refinement process (OCR, OLR and EDM)





Mediterranean Open Access Network (MedOAnet)

- ✓ Coordination of Open Access policies in the region (through surveys, task forces, workshops)
- ✓ Survey of stakeholders in each region




Why OA?

- ✓ Researchers: Visibility, usage, rights, new ways of research (data driven)
- ✓ Institutions: equal access to information (World Health Organization paper)
- ✓ Society: free access to knowledge, helps building knowledge society
- ✓ SMEs: access to information




Green OA. Repositories by country


Green OA. Type of content in repositories

- ✓ LIBER strongly believes in OA to research outputs as a means to build the European Research Area and to encourage Open Scholarship and Open Knowledge
- ✓ LIBER and LIBER members participate in multiple projects around Open Access
- ✓ LIBER strongly collaborates with COAR and SPARC in building a pro-Open Access policy making atmoshpere and a research infraestructure to support it

Open Access to research theses




Theses freely available in

Open Access are more heavily

used than paper equivalents

- ✓ Example: Dublin City University, 2009
- √ 518 consultations of paper theses
- ✓ 16,212 downloads for the equivalent digital theses

LERU Roadmap could be adopted by any RPO interested in exploring the OA road



LERU Roadmap towards Open Access

- ✓ Open Access needs to be viewed in the wider context of Open Scholarship and Open Knowledge
- ✓ Each LERU University could consider appointing a senior Officer to act as Open Access champion
- ✓ Some LERU Universities are interested in collaborations over Open Access publishing, particularly for Open Access monograph publishing in the Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences

LERU roadmap. The Green route

- ✓ Institutional repositories provide a basis for Open Access approaches Costs vary from €30,000 - €242,000 per year in the UK
- ✓ Communications Strategy of the Green route needed to support advocacy
- Universities need to be clear about what type of material is being deposited
- ✓ Open Access Strategy should be embedded in pan-University Strategies

LERU roadmap. The Green route

MedOAnet survey: 15 Turkish universities out of 29 RPOs have a policy

- ✓ LERU Universities can consider adopting Open Access mandates at an institutional level
- ✓ Authors should not assign their copyright to publishers
 - ✓ Better model is for authors to grant non-exclusive rights to an author to publish

Research data, once made available in Open Access, opens up opportunities for re-use and collaboration

Work to be done in this area.
MedOAnet survey: there is not enough awareness of copyright issues in Turkey





LERU roadmap. The Green route

✓ There is a gap in the current European infrastructure for longterm secure digital preservation

✓ Certainly as concerns Open Access repositories and Open Access journals

MedOAnet survey: 2/3 Turkish institutions have no policies re: long term preservation

LERU roadmap. The Gold route

- ✓ Changes are taking place in scholarly publishing across the world
- ✓ Sustainable Business Models for Gold Open Access publishing need to be developed
- ✓ Two models currently exist
 - ✓ Full Open Access journals
 - ✓ Hybrid Journals, which allow Author-Pays charges. Problem of 'double dipping' should be addressed





LERU roadmap. The Gold route

- ✓ LERU could investigate reductions in Author Payment charges with publishers and membership fees with Open Access publishers
- ✓ Changes to existing publishing models will incur transition costs
 - ✓ LERU and/or other Universities can work with other stakeholders to leverage funding
- ✓ LERU institutions can work with Open Access monograph publishers



LERU roadmap. The Gold route

✓ There is a need for a cross-institutional study to identify University commitments to the current publishing models
